REGULAR meeting of the Council of the Township of Rear of Leeds & Lansdowne held in Council Chambers on Monday, May 1, 1989, following the Committee of Adjustment.

\* Council has no objection to the Lion's Club setting off fire works in Centennial Park on July 1, 1989. The Reeve is hereby authorized to sign for the Township as "owner" of the property where the fireworks will be set off.

\* adopted minutes of regular meeting of April 17, 1989, as circulated.

\* approved General Accounts in the amount of \$67,251.39.

\* approved Road Voucher No. 4-1989 in the amount of \$44,010.83.

\* increased grader rental to \$50 per hour.

\* severances dealt with as follows: B-136-89(Wilson) - no objection to severance being granted as this is an easement only. B-211-

89(Loucks) - no objection to severance being granted, subject to 5% of value of land only for park purposes. B-270-89(Canadian National Railway) - no objection to consent being granted, subject to 5% of value of land only. This is an addition to adjoining lands.

\* approved applications for Tile Drainage Loan under the Tile Drainage Act by Keith Sly, for 75% of cost of drain, estimated at \$20,000, the applicant to understand that the loan cannot be made until funds become available from the Ministry of Agriculture and Food and will be made under whatever regulations of the said Ministry that are in effect at the time of making of the loan.

\* supports the position of Township of Lavant, Dalhousie & North Sherbrooke with respect to payment of wolf bounty.

\* supports the resolution of South Crosby respecting increase of funding from the Province.

\* By-law number 16-1989, being a by-law to levy and collect from the rateable property in the Township of Rear of Leeds and Lansdowne certain sums of money to meet the current expenditures required by the said Township and the School Boards therein and the Township share of the United Counties of Leeds & Grenville expenditures for the year 1989.

\* adjournment.

regular meeting of Council of the Township of Rear of Leeds & Lansdowne, held in Council Chambers on Tuesday, May 23, 1989, following the Committee of Adjustment.

\* approved minutes of regular meeting of May 1, 1989 as circulated.

\* approved Kendrick's Park accounts in amount of \$524.46.

\* approved General accounts in amount of \$13,989.02.

\* severance B-320-89-Linscott - no objection to severance being granted, subject to 5% of value of land only for park purposes.

\* By-law 17-1989 - to temporarily close part of Bay Street in Seeley's Bay for a school reunion.

\* By-law 18-1989 - to sell part of the road allowance between lots 18 and 19, Concession 6, Township of Leeds, Municipality of the Township of Rear of Leeds and Lansdowne, County of Leeds.

\* balance in the Reserve for Fire Department, being \$86,000, be cleared and applied to purchase price of the new fire truck, and that the purchase price approved in resolution of 6 March 1989, be amended from \$153,997.00 to \$155,082.00

\* Council confirms that Part of Townline, Concession 7, Lot 14, Twp. of Lansdowne may be stopped, closed & sold to abutting owner, pursuant to By-law 15-1982, this being agreed to by resolution passed November 21, 1983, being Parts 8, 9, 10 and 11, Plan 28R4754.

\* confirms that Tom Berry shall be Park Attendant at Kendrick's Park as recommended by Kendrick's Park Committee of Management.

\* at the request of the Recreation Committee, Council declared May 26 to June 4, 1989 Canada's Fitweek, May 26 being Sneaker Day.

\* adjournment.
