The Council of The Corporation of the Township of South Crosby held Regular Council Meetings for the month of October on the 5th and 19th on the month.

All Council members were present at both meetings with the exception of Deputy-Reeve, Wayne Sly, who was absent from the October 19th meeting, due to his attendance at the ACRO Conference.

By-Law 31-92 was enacted, to amend zoning By-Law 32-83 allowing the temporary use of a Garden Suite.

Motions were passed to authorize the following:

-Council had no objections to the following land severances, pursuant to various conditions: B-378-92; B-390-92; B-406-92; B-407-92.

-that accounts in the amount of \$344,373.13 be accepted and paid

-to support the North Leeds Economic Development Committee with a financial donation of \$200.00

-to support the Town of Newmarket on their Resolution concerning Canadian Unity

NOTICE TO ALL SOUTH CROSBY

Over the past few years the Township of South Crosby Office staff have operated a food bank to assist families in need in the township.

Pursuant to discussion between South Crosby Council and a representative from Family Focus and other community representatives it was decided that Family Focus would look into the possibility of a community run Food Bank which would service all areas of North Leeds. A Committee was then formed to assist in this process.

The Council of South Crosby support this transition of responsibility and urge people from the North Leeds area to continue to support the food bank as they have so readily done in the past.

The food bank is located at the corner of Halladay and Church Street in the village of Elgin in the "Old" Public School.

Mrs. Joan Hargrave is the volunteer co-ordinator and can be reached Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday at 359-1069. A core group of volunteers work the food bank during the operating hours.

Councillor Carr reported that the collection of food and donations, for the Food Bank, are going very well. Following a discussion it was agreed that a notice go in the North Leeds Lantern advising the public that the Food Bank that was operated out of the Municipal Office, has been transferred over to the North Leeds Food Bank, and that the Corporation of the Township of South Crosby do support this transition and asks the public continue to support the Food Bank, as it has so readily done in the past.
