Minutes were read and approved. Roll call showed 10 members and 1 visitor present.

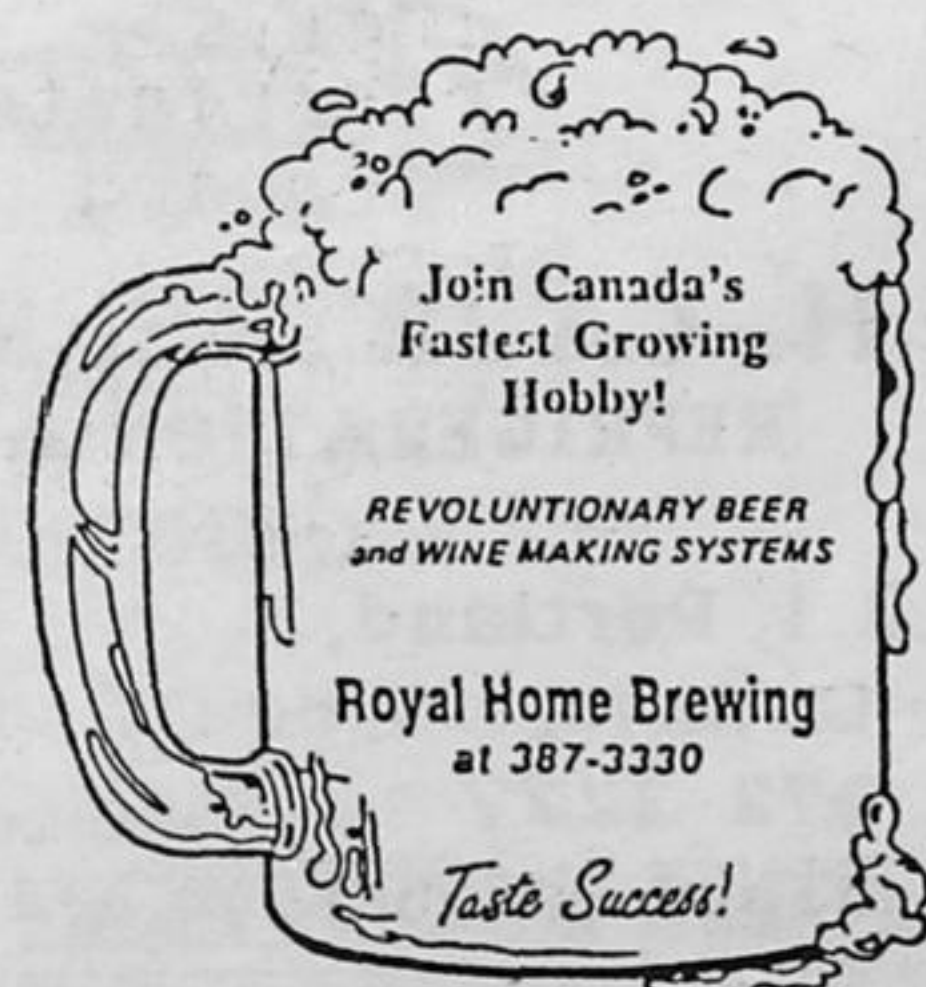
