

"exceptional contribution" to an organization whose motto is "Our Strength People Working is Together". The presentation made was by Govenor-General Raymond J. Hnatyshyn, a CUSO patron, at Rideau Hall in Ottawa.

The Govenor-General noted that the Gervans were recognized for their contribution to CUSO both overseas and here at home. Paul and Evelyn met while studying at Queen's University. They served with CUSO for three years in Malaysia in the early 1970s. They also spent time in India Sri Lanka.
