Our funds are generally matched by different levels of government. They are distributed through the church organizations already in place worldwide. Overhead is kept to a minimum.

The Parish of the Rideau holds an annual WALKATHON in September to raise money for this project. We do this by obtaining pledges for distance walked, or by lump sum contributions.

Following a service at Holy Trinity Church, Lombardy, we will walk by the back roads all or part of the 13 kilometres to St. Peter's Church at Newboyne. There we will share in lunch and a time of really good fellowship.

ADVISORY COUNCIL ON AGING FOR LANARK, LEEDS AND GRENVILLE COUNTIES

SMITHS FALLS--A grant of \$35,484 under the New Horizons Program has been made to the Advisory Council on Aging for Lanark, Leeds and Grenville Counties. Announcement of the approval was made by Monique Vezina, the minister of state for seniors.

Advisory Council president Keith Pelton, of Brockville, termed the grant "timely indeed. It will be of tremendous assistance as we continue to develop our philosophy of exploring avenues to improve and sustain the well-being of the elderly in these counties."

In her letter, the minister congratulated Advisory Council members on planning and organization, and expressed her wish "for continued success in your endeavours."

The grant will enable the Advisory Council to expand its activities across the three counties, Pelton said, including the hiring of an executive director who will work out of the Smiths Falls headquarters.

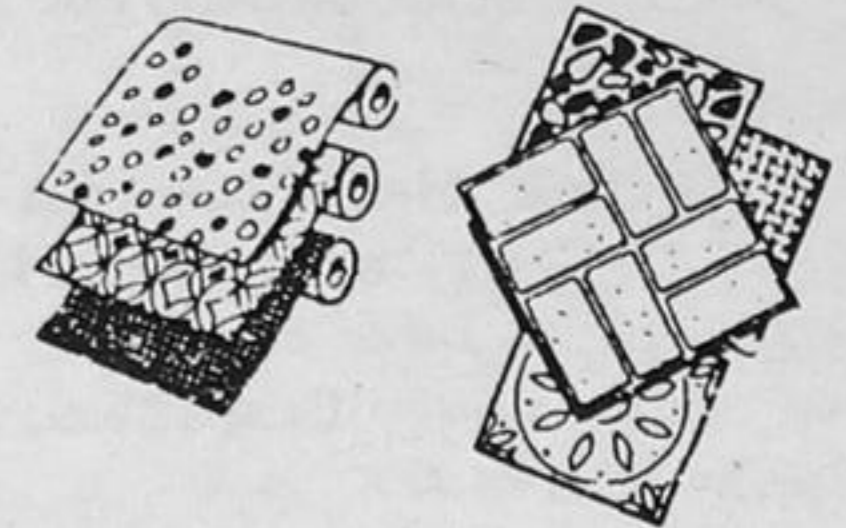
Formed earlier this year, after public meetings and discussions that covered a period of some two years, the Advisory Council is headed by a 16-member board of directors.

One of the major projects to be undertaken in the immediate future, Pelton said, is to cooperate with the ministry of community and social services in the redirection of long-term care. Towards this end, a public meeting is expected to be held, likely in October, when the role of the Advisory Council in long-term care will be addressed.

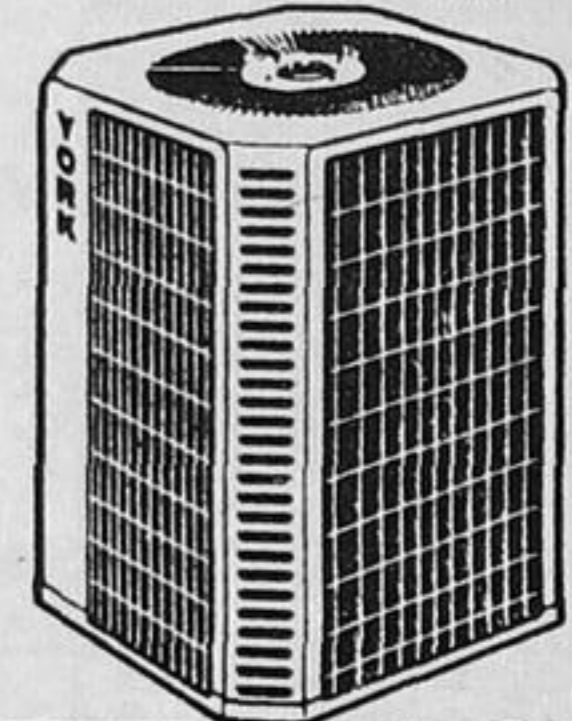
