Until a member of my family weight loss joined program I didn't even think in terms of low-But having a cal jam. bush currant huge red a continual craving for the berries I purchased box of "Certo Light" last and ate all away takes The jam winter. prepare, minutes to economical and the combinations fruit as endless your as imagination. This will not keep longer than 3 weeks in the frig after opening due to reduced sugar so use a size of jar suitable to your needs. Directions no-cook freezer Certo Light does jam. artificial contain not sweeteners, it is a natural pectin product. You use 1/3 less sugar and 20% more fruit. The cost of making was one half the price of a brand name from Loblaws. The jar vary in caloric jams spoonful, content per blueberry for example has 26 calories, peach I used frozen at 49. unthawed berries and made my jam in December because my craving was at its peak and I also needed Christmas edible some This winter presents. I will experiment with apricots.

Light Red Currant Jam

- 5½ cups mashed red
- currants
- 1 box CERTO LIGHT
- 3½ cups sugar
- 2 tsp. lemon juice
 (optional)
- Sterilize jars, cool slightly before filling.
- Measure clean fruit into heavy saucepan. Add 1/8 tsp butter to prevent foaming.
- Measure sugar and set aside. Do not reduce sugar.
- 4. Combine Certo Light with 4 cup of your premeasured sugar. Set remaining sugar aside. Slowly add Certo mixture to prepared fruit in pan.
- 5. Place over high
 heat and stir
 constantly until
 mixture comes to
 a full boil. Stir
 in remaining sugar.
 Stir constantly as
 mixture returns to
 a full rolling
 boil. Continue to
 stir to prevent
 sticking and boil
 hard one minute.

6. Remove from heat and skim off foam.

Bottle according to directions found in box.


