On November 12th, 1991 I would appreciate your support at the polls.

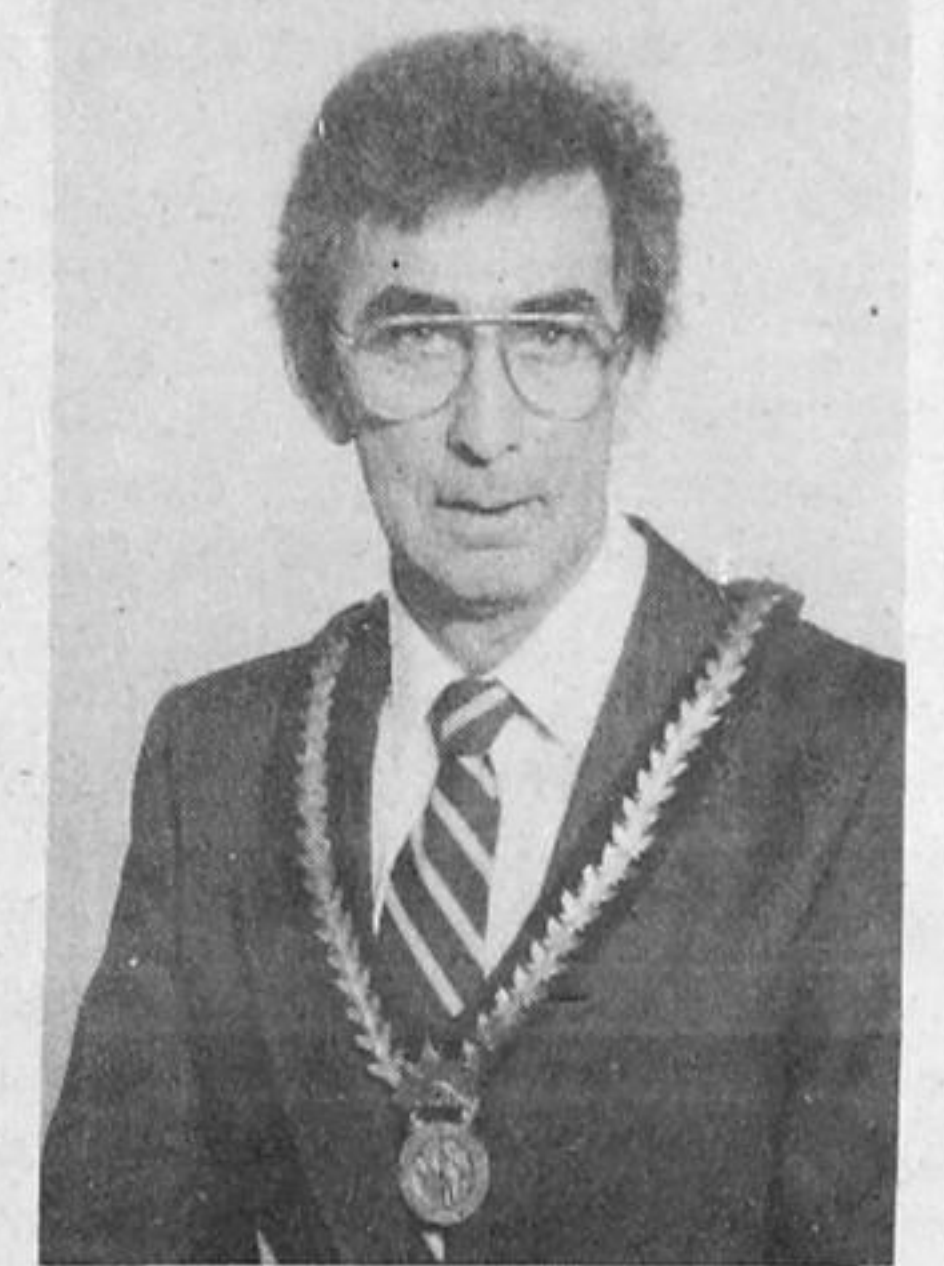
