ONTARIO BREAST SCREENING PROGRAM-KINGSTON CENTRE

Are you a women 50 years or older? Do you have a wife, sister, daughter, mother or grandmother over the age of 50? If so, then you or your loved one is at increased risk for breast cancer. Regular breast screening and early detection can save lives.

The OBSP Kingston Centre is located at 786 Blackburn Mews. The Centre is part of a Ministry of Health provincially-funded initiative to screen all women in Ontario, 50 years or older, every two years for breast cancer.

Why? Because studies have shown that in this age group, early detection of breast cancer saves lives.

Screening consists of physical examination of the breasts by a nurse-examiner and a breast x-ray called a mammogram. Women can make an appointment themselves by calling 384-4284 or toll free 1-800-465-8850, or their doctor can refer them. This service is free.
