The last meeting for the summer of the Delta U.C.W. was held in the Church hall with Vivian Morris acting for President Irma Chant who has been ill.



For the second consecutive year PERRAS has been named Female Vocalist of the Year, and the pair have been honoured again as Duet of the Year, at the Canadian Country Music Association Awards. Along with a highly successful appearance at the Randy Travis Show in Toronto's Maple Leaf Gardens, the duo have a current hit single, ONE SMOKEY ROSE. Written

Born in Ottawa, but raised in Merrickville and Delta, Mr. Leeson developed his vocal and instrumental skills as a teenager. Because of a health condition which prevented him from engaging in competitive sports, he turned to guitar studies to occupy his time. He is self taught.

Early employment as a musician began with local part-time bands in the mid Stints with Kim 1980's. Landon & Brass Buckle, of Lyndhurst, and Ron Gordon's Rambling Fever band in Kingston led to his decision to try full-time band work in 1986.

That year brought tours of western Canada, northern Ontario, and the Atlantic Provinces with the Ottawa band, Midnite Sun. In 1987 Jef spent three months in central Ontario with London country artist Shawn Travis before joining Dennis Whitty & Bushwacker in Ottawa, where he has spent the last eight months.

Although he plays bass

guitar professionally, Mr. Leeson has also mastered acoustic and electric guitars, drums, and keyboard well enough to allow him to compose and record in his He also home studio. performs lead and backup vocals.

The son of Richard and Alice Leeson of Delta, Jef attended Beverley Elementary School there and R.D.H.S. at Elgin before completing Television Production course at Belleville's Loyalist College. According to Mr. Leeson, credit for the early stimulation of his interest in both the technical and performing arts lies with electronics teacher Robert Huntley, music teacher Ann Landon, and members of Brockville Operatic Society where he appeared in the boys' chorus in Oliver; and as a mobster's sidekick in Guys & Dolls. A lead role in the Belleville Pinnacle Theatre's production of No Sex Please, We're British, was a further spur to his aspirations.

Jef's first local appearance with Anita Perras & Tim Taylor will be at the Rodeo Roadhouse in Kingston from June 28th to July 2nd.
