BASTARD AND SOUTH BURGESS ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION COMMITTEE

Highlights of the 1987 Program:

This Committee was set up by By-Law 640 passed April 7, 1986 and is responsible to Council for approval of its programs and activities. The Committee meets monthly and the following briefly summarizes some of the 1987 activities of the Committee.

Establishment of a successful Bluebird Trail of 36 houses on the Cedar valley Road with the participation of Grade 5 and 6 students from Rideau Centennial School. 2) A small number of pine and spruce trees were distributed last spring most of which went to enhance the Delta Park. 3) The Committee participated in the Ministry of Environment Self Help Program by recruiting several people to do weekly water - Adjourned to meet again sampling in several local lakes during the past summer season.

4) The committee had considerable

correspondence with Ontario Hydro and the Ministry of the Environment on the question of environmental controls during and after the construction of the Ontario Hydro 500 RV lines. Anyone wishing information on this could contact the Committee.

5) A very important concern for the future is the question of garbage disposal and recycling. The Committee held a meeting with the recycling office of the Ministry of Environment from Toronto and Council members attended.

Following this meeting the Committee recommended to Council that the Municipality consider inviting a number of surrounding

Municipalities to meet with the Ministry to discuss the possibility of developing a Master Plan for Garbage Disposal.

The Committee has also been following the preparation of a set of proposed Rideau Cana1 Policies by Parks Canada, encouraged has experimentation with loan nesting platforms, and has attended meeting on the development of a Fisheries Management Plan.
