Have you ever felt the urge to trace your "family tree"? Here's your chance to get expert advice and useful pointers from best-selling author and genealogist Angus Baxter, presented by the Rideau Lakes Union Public Library at the Seeley's Bay Library Room, on Monday, 21 September at 8 p.m. Admission is \$1.00 (free to season ticket holders).

Angus Baxter is the author of three best-selling books on genealogy: In Search of Your Roots, In Search of Your British and Irish Roots and In Search of Your European Roots (recently chosen by the American Library Association as one of the 4 best reference books published in North America in 1986). Mr. Baxter has been researching genealogy for over forty years and is a long-time member of several genealogical organisations both here and overseas. He has traced his own family back to the early 14th century!

Angus Baxter is a relaxed and seasoned speaker, having given over 800 lectures on ancestor-hunting in the past 8 years, as well as some 150 appearances on television and radio programmes in most parts of Canada and the United States. He is Associate Editor of Heritage Quest, one of the leading genealogical magazines, and is a frequent contributor to magazines and newspapers around the world.
