NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING  
PROPOSED OFFICIAL PLAN AMENDMENT

**TAKE NOTICE** that the Council of the Corporation of the Township of South Crosby will hold a public meeting on May 31, 1989 at 7:30 p.m. at the Township of South Crosby Municipal Office to consider a proposed Official Plan amendment under Sections 17 and 21 of the Planning Act.

The proposed Official Plan amendment would revise the policies for Community Improvement contained in Section 4.16 to reflect the updated information contained in a report prepared for the Township. The report reviews the community improvement needs and opportunities of the whole Township. It recommends Elgin be designated as the primary policy area, and Chaffey's Lock and Morton as the secondary policy areas. It also recommends an implementation strategy for community improvement.

**ANY PERSON** may attend the public meeting and/or make written or verbal representation either in support of or in opposition to the proposed Official Plan amendment.

**ADDITIONAL INFORMATION** relating to the proposed Official Plan amendment is available for inspection between 9:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. at the Township Office.
