TriCAP is an addictions treatment agency funded by the Community Mental Health Branch of the Ministry of Health to provide accessible, non-residential, short-term counselling in Lanark, Leeds and Grenville for substance abusers and their families. Its Board of Directors and staff will work with other addiction agencies to increase accessibility and quality of treatment addiction for problems. Present staffing is focussed on youth and families, and application has been made to the Ministry of Health for funds to serve adults as well by the end of the year.

Ann Kilpatrick, Director of Nursing, Carleton Place Hospital, is the Chairman of the Board of Directors. Rick Lotan, Vice Principal, Carleton Place High School, is the Vice Chairman, and Peter McKenna, Coordinator, Addiction Brockville and Assessment Centre, is the Treasurer. 


