Moved by Connell/Sly that the Council of the Corporation of the Township of South Crosby do hereby agree that a fee of \$10.00 be charged to any person from outside the Township of South Crosby who wishes to dump at the Waste Disposal Site. And further, that this same fee be charged to any Township Resident who brings any items or material in from outside of the Township. Carried.

Councillor Linda Carr, Chairperson of the Policy and Procedures Committee, reported that there are no recommendations for changes to policies regarding work done on private roads, at the present time.

It was also reported by Councillor Carr that the Policy and Procedures Committee recommend that special warning signs not be the responsibility of the Township of South Crosby. By-Law for this policy is to be drawn up and presented for consideration at next Council meeting.

Moved by Sly/Carr that this meeting adjourn at 11:00p.m. and reconvene on Monday, June 12th, 1989 at the Municipal Office, to further consider township business. Carried.

Monday, June 12, 1989:

Moved by Sly/Carr that the General Office Accounts in the amount of \$7,366.24, be accepted and paid. Carried.

By-Law Number 16-89, a by-law to amend Zoning By-Law Number 32-83, was tabled for discussion at a future meeting, due to the fact that information required has not been received.

Request for tile drainage loan was considered. Appropriate by-law to be considered at a future meeting, when work is completed.

Moved by Sly/Stedman that the Council of the Corporation of the Township of South Crosby have no objections to survey of portion of road allowance Pt Lot 20, between Concession 8&9. Carried.

By-Law Number 15-89 was read a second and third time and passed this 12th day of June, 1989. Carried.

Consideration and discussion was held regarding County Government in Ontario. The discussion related to several areas of the report which Council members disagreed with, such as size of Municipalities, representation on County Council, name of Head of Council, planning at the County level and County-wide assessment. A report is to be compiled and sent to the United counties of Leeds and Grenville.

Moved by Sly/Stedman that the Council of the Corporation of the Township of South Crosby agree in principle with the draft plan of survey in relation to the proposed plan of subdivision by Michael Meredith. Carried.


Linda Carr, Chairperson of the Policy and Procedures Committee, reported that the Committee made the following

recommendations:

1. That special warning signs not be the responsibility of the Township and that a by-law be prepared to adopt this policy.
2. That no changes be made to policies concerning Land Severances.
3. That Council members be reimbursed for expenses twice a year - July 1st and November 15th and that their honorariums be paid in two installments, on these same dates.

Clerk advised Council that a verbal complaint has been received regarding the noise and rough language at the Elgin Tavern, specifically on Friday and Saturday nights, and also the fact that this continues into the early hours of the morning. Letter is to be written to residents with concerns and advise that they should direct their concerns to Elgin Police Village Trustees.


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
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
