The Council of the Corporation of the Township of South Crosby met on Monday, January 15, 1990, with all members present.

Copies of the minutes of the previous meeting held on Tuesday, January 2, 1990, were distributed, read and approved.

*Dawne Smith attended Council meeting to give an up-date report to Council on the activities of and services being provided by Guthrie House.

*Marion McLeod attended Council meeting to re-affirm and up-date Council on the existence of the Senior Support Services provided by V.O.N.

*Approved payment of General Office accounts, in the amount of \$6,661.96.

* Resolved that the Council of the Corporation of the Township of South Crosby object to the insufficient denominations of postage stamps available at all Post Offices in our area, thus mailing a letter was almost impossible.

Due to the fact that postage is received from Montreal, it takes three to four weeks for delivery of stamps, making it impossible for postmasters to serve their public in a prompt fashion.

That sufficient stamps should be in place at the time of postage increases.

* Approved payment of Road Voucher No.1, in the amount of \$9,186.37.

*Road Superintendent gave his report.

*Resolved to petition the Ministry of Transportation Ontario for year end expenditures for the year 1989.
Construction \$ 85,580.80
Maintenance \$236,579.47
\$322,160.27

*Agreed that the Council accept \$250.00 as cash settlement in lieu of land for park purposes under the Planning Act, in each case, relating to Land Severance File Numbers B578-88 and B-579-88, in the name of Mr. Earl McFadden.

*Agreed that Council support, in principle, OI Cable System Inc.'s application to CRTC to provide cable television service to the Village of Elgin.

*Approved the hours of operation for the General Office be from 8:30a.m. to 4:30p.m. on a year-round basis effective February 5, 1990.

*Agreed that James Stedman and Robert Smith be appointed as Council representatives to serve on the Committee of Adjustment for the year 1990.

*Meeting adjourned at 10:43p.m.

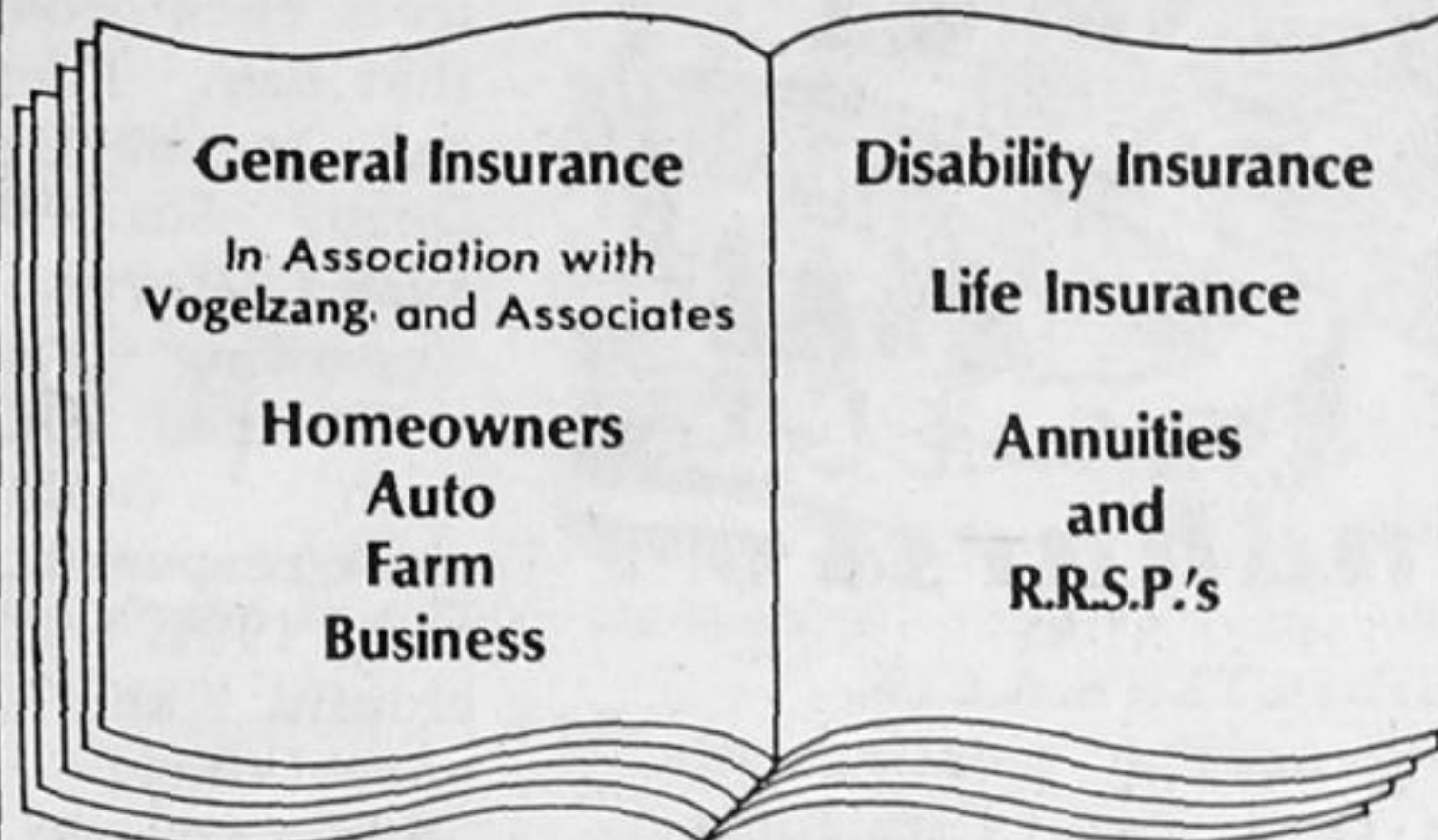
SOUTH CROSBY

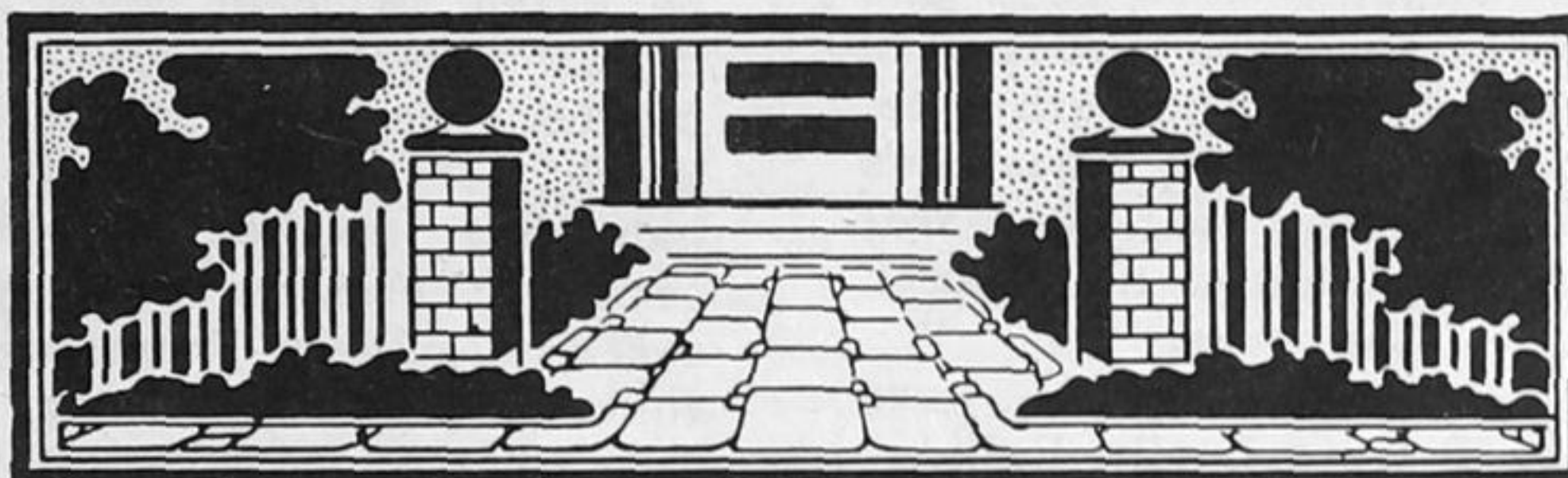
