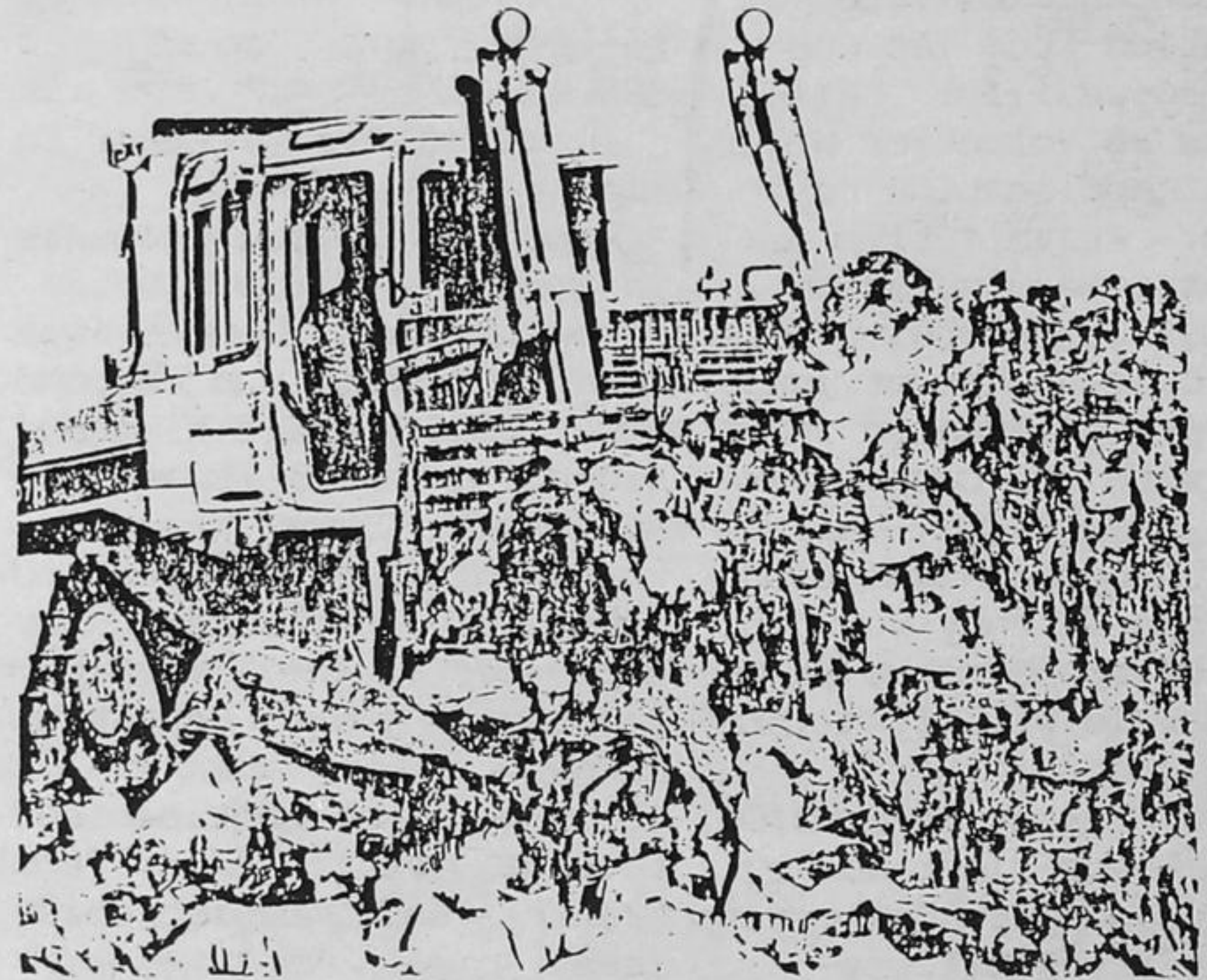


BASTARD AND SOUTH BURGESS
WASTE DISPOSAL SITES
INFORMATION AND PROCEDURES

INFORMATION

1. Recycling Bins will be placed at the sites. (For newspapers, cans, soft drink plastic bottles). Other glass bottles can be brought to the sites in containers and disposed of in our extra compartment bin. Recyclables will be accepted on the first and third Saturdays of each month. Start up date to be announced soon.
2. Compost Containers are available at the Municipal Office for placement on your private property for your own use. (Nominal fee will be charged).
3. A defined area at our sites will be identified for the disposing of brush (properly bundled) and compost material (eg. leaves, etc.)
4. Awaiting further approval from the Ministry of Environment, we will possibly have "Blue Boxes" available for those who wish to use for recycling. (We will keep you informed if the containers become available).
5. Plans are being processed for a day designated as "Hazardous and Toxic Waste Disposal Day", possibly the fall of 1990.
6. Triple washed cans from pesticides, herbicides etc. are not considered hazardous.

POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

1. Please READ the information in your "Pass Book".
2. Clarification in Pass Book: Regulation Item 1: Should read 2 free trips per week.

Regulation Item 5 (a) Surcharge of \$5.00 per item. - Furniture includes television, chesterfields, chairs, mattresses etc. Appliances includes stoves, fridges, dishwashers, microwaves, water tanks etc.

Regulation Item 5 (b) a surcharge of \$1.00 each is to be levied for tires.

A TICKET MUST BE PURCHASED BEFORE DISPOSAL OF ANY OF THE ABOVE. TICKETS ARE AVAILABLE AT THE MUNICIPAL OFFICE OR ONE OF THE TWO OUTLETS:
a) Rob's Corner Garage and Store, Portland, 272-2883
b) Stearry's Service Centre, Delta, 928-2441.

THE ATTENDANT WILL COLLECT THE TICKET.

Placement of the above items will be directed by the Attendant on duty.
3. Cardboard boxes must be flattened and bundled.
4. Glass bottles in a container will be accepted during the "Recycling Days". THERE MUST NOT BE ANY BROKEN GLASS IN THE CONTAINER. No tops please.
5. ATTENTION CONTRACTORS: Single Axle trucks or tandem trucks must have a receipt from the Township office to be admitted to the site. (See Pass Book for rates).
