

**COUNCIL NOTES**

Regular meeting of Council of the Township of Rear of Leeds and Lansdowne, held in Council Chambers on Monday, May 4, 1987, at 7:30 p.m.

- \* no objection to Ontario Hydro installing underground service to Michael Berry's new house under the Township Road known as Back Street, provided the service is 4 feet below road surface.
- \* approved General Accounts in amount of \$16,910.46.
- \* approved Road Voucher No. 4-1987 in amount of \$14,833.30.
- \* approved Lyndhurst Private Abatement Accounts in amount of \$1,020.00, which includes grant as recommended by Kostuck Engineering Limited to property referenced #26.
- \* no objection to severance B-189-87 being granted, subject to 5% of value of land only for Park Purposes.
- \* a By-law to levy and collect from the rateable property in the Township of Rear of Leeds and Lansdowne certain sums of money to meet the current expenditures required by the said Township and the School Boards therein and the Township share of the United Counties of Leeds & Grenville expenditures for the year 1987, be read a first time and second time, read a third time, signed under Seal by the Reeve and Clerk-Treasurer and numbered 8-1987.
- \* no objection to increase in tonnage of materials taken from licenced pits under Account No. P61-3972 & P61-3973 (W.P.Green & Sons Limited).
- \* Bill Wood appointed to the Kendrick's Park Committee of Management.
- \* no objection to the Lion's Club setting off Fire Works in Centennial Park on July 1, 1987. The Reeve is hereby authorized to sign for the Township as "owner" of the property where the fireworks will be set off.
- \* request of Vera Dessels

to purchase part of water front at Kendrick's Park be declined as it is Council's opinion that sale of any park land is not in the public interest.

- \* confirmed Tom Berry as Park Attendant at Kendrick's Park as per tender submitted.
- \* Ken Kelsey, Crane Building Services, Donald Paige, Doug Clarke, and Stanley Hartley be requested to submit quotes for labour and material to rebuild Lyndhurst Dock to existing size.
- \* adjournment.

Regular meeting of Council of the Township of Rear of Leeds and Lansdowne, held in Council Chambers on Tuesday, May 19, 1987, following the Committee of Adjustment Meeting.

- \* approved general accounts in amount of \$17,730.61.
- \* approved Centennial Park accounts in amount of \$2,624.00
- \* approved Kendrick's Park accounts in amount of \$432.68.
- \* invited Brockville Truck Center, Edward's Ford, Braden Ford, Rockway Pontiac, Code Ford Mercury, Gananoque Chev. Olds. Ltd. and Doyle Chevrolet, Oldsmobile, Cadillac Ltd. to submit truck tenders. Tenders to be received in the Township Office by 4:30 p.m. Monday June 15, 1987 and opened at the regular meeting on June 15, 1987.
- \* no objection to severances B-214-87 and B-225-87 subject to 5% of value of land only for Park Purposes and conveyance of up to 33 feet from centre of Township Road, for future road widening.
- \* with respect to condition of severance regarding adequate mainland parking and boat launching facilities being provided in Severance applications B-108-87, B-109-87 and B-110-87, Mr. McGill has provided a letter confirming an agreement with Daniel Kelsey for parking space on Mr. Kelsey's farm, Lot 22, Concession 8 of Township of Rear of Younge and Escott,

for 21 years.

- \* "adequate parking" shall mean a minimum of 21 year lease of lands, or ownership of land for parking and boat docking facility.
- \* expresses thanks to Tom Tennant of the Fire Marshalls Office for the work put into the Report on Municipal Fire Protection Survey. Receipt of the Report is

acknowledged by Council, the recommendations to be reviewed.

- \* WHEREAS the report on municipal fire protection Survey, prepared by the Office of Fire Marshall, recommends more fire training for volunteer fire men, AND WHEREAS volunteer firemen do not have much time to spare for training courses and fire schools, and whereas there are no Fire Schools and few courses offered in Eastern Ontario, NOW THEREFORE, the Solicitor General be requested to provide facilities for better volunteer training that are more accessible to volunteer firefighter who work full time at other jobs.
- \* requested Ministry of Municipal Affairs to review the Report on Municipal Fire Protection Survey to determine cost and methods of financing the capital expenditures set out in the Report.
- \* approved Preliminary Application for loan under the Ontario Home Renewal Program Number 0816000110, as applicant qualifies by way of ownership and income.
- \* at request of residents, a Neighbourhood Watch sign and post be purchased for Ellisville road at County road 3.
- \* adjournment
