Sift together 1 cup flour 1 tbsp baking powder 3/4 tsp salt and combine it with 1 cup whole wheat flour 1/4 cup fresh grated Parmesan cheese ½ tsp oregano. Stir in 2/3 cup tomato juice 6 tbsp butter, melted and cooled and form the mixture into a smooth dough. Turn the dough out onto a floured surface and knead it for Roll out the 30 seconds. dough 1/2 inch thick and cut 2 inch rounds. the rounds on a baking sheet, brush with melted butter and bake in the upper third of a very hot oven (450°) for 10 to 12 minutes. Makes about 16.

Pour in large bowl; stir in cucumber, milk and cream. refrigerate Cover and When ready overnight. to serve, add ½ cup cold milk, if needed. Taste for Garnish with seasoning. 11 Makes chives. cups, about 185 calories per cup.
