


KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION

Junior Kindergarten Registration and Early Childhood Screening

The Leeds and Grenville County Board of Education invites parents of Junior Kindergarten and Kindergarten-aged pupils to register for the 1987-88 School Year.

Please call your local school on or before Feb. 6, 1987.

Junior Kindergarten pupils must be 4 years of age on or before December 31, 1987.

Kindergarten pupils must be 5 years of age on or before December 31, 1987.

Early Childhood Screening

In co-operation with the Lanark, Leeds and Grenville District Health Unit, a Health Screening and Information session will be held at each school for parents of children 3 to 5 years old.

The Health Screening includes: Vision, hearing and Dental Assessment, and an opportunity for parents to discuss the development of their pre-school-aged children. Where appropriate, a referral to other community agencies or services will be provided.

For Junior Kindergarten and Kindergarten registration, verification of tax support, proof of age (birth certificate) and the child's immunization record will be required. If the child is to be transported by bus, the school office will need to know the Lot and Concession number of the residence.

Please phone the local public school on or before February 6 to schedule an appointment for this registration.
