Winter is inevitably coming. We all prepare for it. Some of us are busy harvesting the rich produce of our gardens, while others are over what winter mulling embark upon project to to ease the passage of these "long dark months".

What about our senior citizens or handicapped neighbours who find it difficult - almost impossible to "get about" during the winter due to mobility transportation or difficulties? We all know that almost someone disappears over the winter months and reappears in when weather the summer kinder to travel are the senior citizen.

The VON Volunteer Visiting Program in Bastard and Burgess township has within its first year of existence matched 16 visitors to 16 together clients and celebrated over 1,000 hours of visits. The goal of the program is to provide social support to the seniors and/or to their families in the form of friendly visits that allow them to maintain social with contact their communities and give them the sense of well being that from involvement evolves and caring with other people. Our clients live alone independently or with their spouse.

Visitors are matched a one to one basis to seniors. Matches are made by the coordinator who interviews and screens all volunteers and then based upon mutual

interests personality, and brings the visitor and senior together. Inservice training is provided in informal monthly meetings that allow the coordinator to monitor air concerns as well information share regarding ongoing home support programs or activities of interest. All information

regarding home visits are kept confidential. Referral to other home support services are made when appropriate.

The average weekly visit is $1\frac{1}{2}$ to 2 hours. The frequency and length of are decided these visits upon by the volunteers and the client with the coordinator providing guidance where necessary. Activities may walks, shopping, include: doctor's appointments, drives, reading, learning new hobbies, wheels to meals program, conversation tea and whatever that is of interest to both parties.

The seniors enjoy their new acquaintance and experience a sense of involvement and a sharing of new interests.

The visitors claim that they enjoy the visits as much or more than the seniors because they not only provide an invaluable line to the community's history, giving them a rich sense of continuity and meaning, but also they receive their unconditional acceptance and friendship.

When you are planning your winter project consider becoming a Volunteer Visitor and become involved in your community. I cannot think of a better way to enrich personal development than to make a special friendship with a senior citizen and share experiences and a little bit of time.
