

Passed a by-law "to authorize a fire protection agreement with the Village of Westport". Passed by-laws "to amend the building by-law for the Township of Bastard & South Burgess and "to govern the proceedings of the Council and Committees".

Agreed to purchase computer on condition that Real Time the accepts schedule. payment Garnet Hart Appointed and Frank Eysaman to the Environmental Conservation Committee. Approved one OHRP and grant Authorized severances. Superintendent Park the re-tender for the construction of a comfort station at Lower Beverley Township Park. 


