

WE DO CARE!


As we peruse the daily papers and read all of the sad and desperate stories of our fellow beings in need, it is most rewarding to hear and see the actions being taken by local residents in the caring of others. While many of us give to various agencies, from Oxfam to the United Way, it is sometimes so easy to salve the conscience with a monetary donation and then put everything out of one's mind.

Not so with a couple of groups in our area. The Philipsville Neighbourhood Outreach Group with the Wheels to Meals program, bring a pleasant afternoon to many of our more senior residents, who, while maybe not in need of many material things, like all of us, find the isolation of winter a little hard to bear. Having an excellent meal, with friends and acquaintances from around the area, followed by a social time can make those long dreary "bad weather" days seem a little brighter. The hard-working group of volunteers provide a fantastic meal for a reasonable price, pick up and return those who either have no transportation or are wary of driving in the winter and as an added bonus, deliver meals to those who, for whatever reason cannot attend in person. The enjoyment experienced is not only of the food but for the companionship experienced. An excellent caring program from within our own community!

The second group formed under the banner of the Inter-Church Fellowship Group. As again we read in city papers the need for Food Banks to feed those in unfortunate circumstances, the general feeling among most of us is that the problem doesn't occur here! This group, made up of ministers and lay people of various denominations, saw that we do indeed have people in need of some of the basics, such as food, clothing and shelter. A Food Bank was the first suggested project and, after a few weeks, is now well underway. Non-perishable food items

can be left at any of the area churches following which it is distributed through the Municipal Clerks of the Townships. The recipients remain anonymous and according to all accounts, those in need are being assisted in a very concrete way. Upcoming projects for

discussion include the possible provision of low cost rental units to those who are living in substandard accomodation. Another "made-at-home" project worthy of support and commendation. PL
