Re: FIRES (Grass)

Please notify your local Fire Chief, before starting a grass fire in the Township of Bastard and South Burgess, or you can be held liable for charges if it becomes necessary for you to require the use of the Fire Department.

The charges for burning without prior permission from the Fire Chief are as follows:

- 1 \$300.00 for the first hour spent by the Fire Department in whose area the fire is located.
- 2 \$200.00 for each additional hour or part thereof for the Fire Department in whose area the fire is.
- 3 \$100.00 for each additional tanker or pumper required to extinguish the fire per hour.

CARELESSNESS WITH FIRES WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.
