- \$300.00 for the first hour spent by the Fire Department in whose area the fire is located.
- 2 \$200.00 for each additional hour or part thereof for the Fire Department in whose area the fire is.
- \$100.00 for each additional tanker or pumper required to extinguish the fire per hour.
