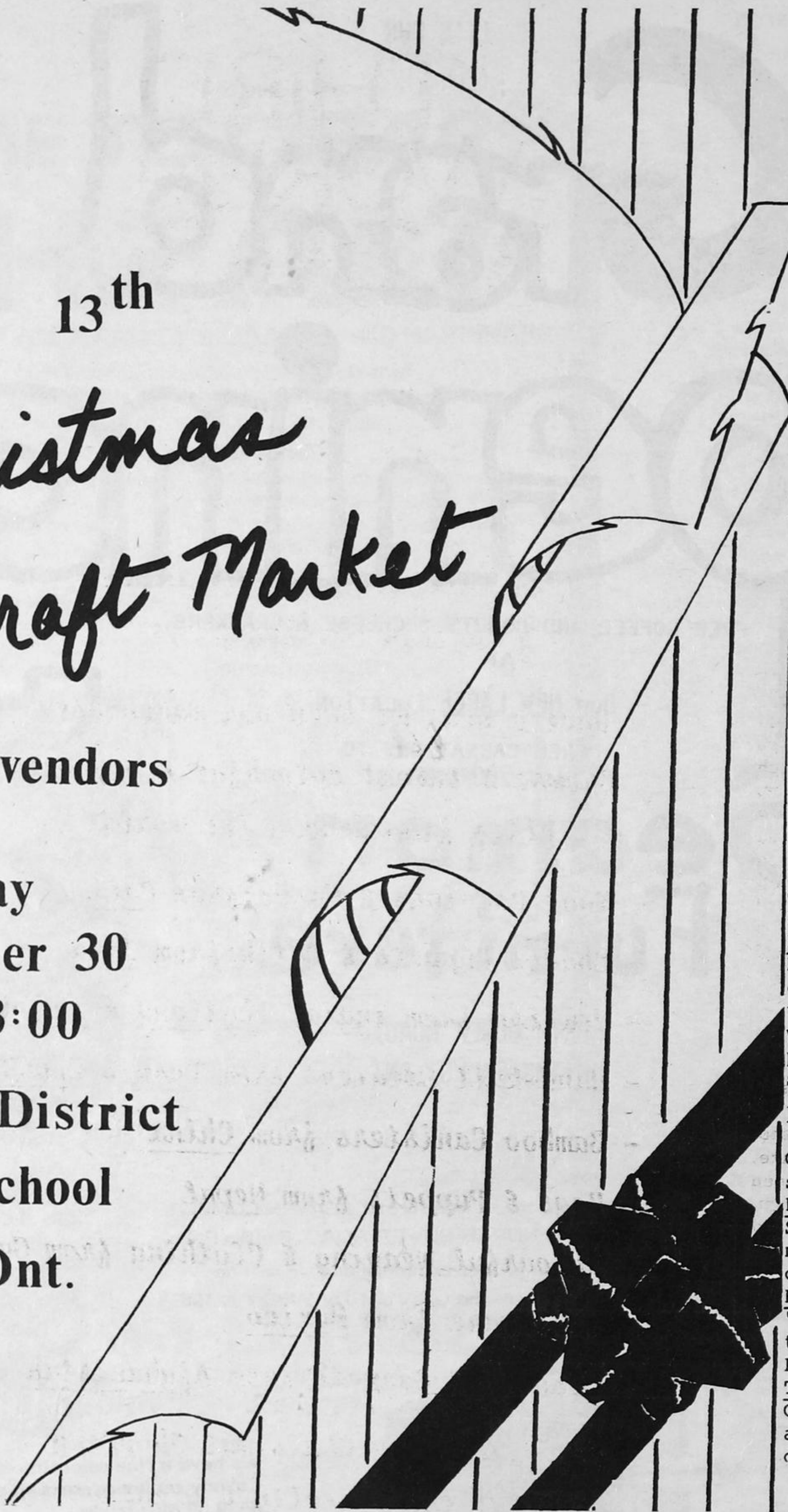

## RIDEAU REVIEW

Many of the new fall books are already available to members of the Union system. In keeping with the time of the year, several titles relating to the war years are included in this review.

Bombers and Mash by Raynes Minns - Beginning as a collection of material selected from war-time cook-books, the author also has built a picture of the contributions and deprivations of the "women's war. An excellent contribution to the women who gave so much for the war effort.

The Uniforms of the World's Great Armies - ed. by I.T. Schick. An excellent addition showing military uniforms from the 1700's to the present.

The Last Days of MASH by the Alda's - a funny and poignant look at the making of the last of the MASH series.

Conquering Heroes by Elizabeth Phillips. A novel of the post-war days in Germany, illustrating the difficulty of a young German girl in accepting her country's defeat and the feelings of superiority of some English children living in post-war Germany. An insight into bigotry and revenge.

Hollaran's World War by Tim Mahoney - Using the scenario of a returning Vietnam war veteran attempting to cope with peace-time, Mahoney presents a "Catch 22" situation with the hero learning to "get even" rather than take revenge.

Other titles reaching the shelves this month:

Everything to Live for by Susan White-Bowden - a mother's story of the suicide of her teenage son.

Bingo by Roger Caron - all the "inside" events surrounding the Prison riot at Kingston Penitentiary.

The Money Rustlers by P. Grescoe & D. Cruise - a look at the self-made millionaires of the New West.
