

Use a piece of cherry for the nose, and cloves for the eyes.





CO-OPERATIVE NURSERY SCHOOL FILLING NEED

The Westport and District Co-Operative Nursery School Association held its first meeting of the new year at the home of Mrs. Sue Flegg with the Co-Ordinator, Chris Trowbridge chairing the meeting. A time for discussion was held giving the parents an opportunity to present any problems or new ideas for the school.

Mothers who cannot be present for their duty day were asked to find a replacement and the feasibility of setting up a group of alternate people for this purpose was examined.

Mrs. Perry McQuay suggested that since this is a co-operative nursery, parents might supplement Mrs. Green's program with their various talents or new ideas, thus furthering the quality of experience for the children. Several examples were cited: having the children observe birds feeding at Foley Mountain; inviting various guests to the Nursery, e.g. - policemen or firemen, so that the children may become familiar with their style of dress as well as learning some basic safety rules. Anyone who could demonstrate various musical instrument would also capture the interest of the children. These ideas will be discussed more fully with Mrs. Green.

The Nursery school is in need of financial assistance and it is hoped that some local group will see this as a real need and be helpful. It has certainly proven itself an important aspect of community life and is filling a definite need here. Country and village children alike are benefitting from the availability of this school. It is an invaluable preparation for kindergaten and Westport is fortunate to have the services of such a well qualified and talented teacher as Mrs. Heather Green.
