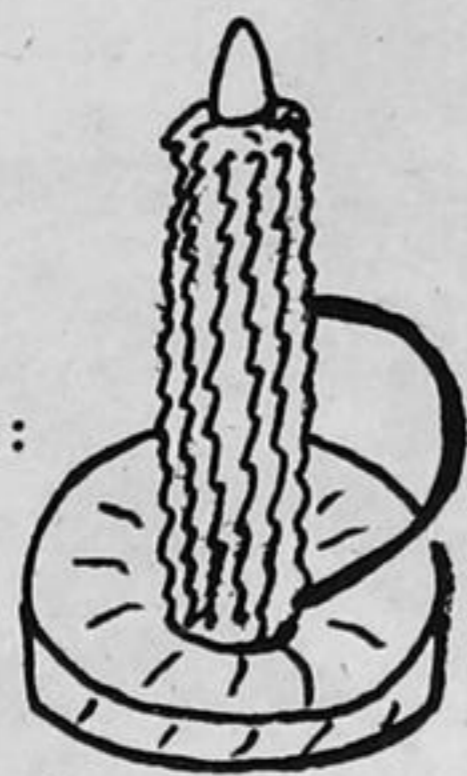
KIDS IN THE KITCHEN

BANANA CANDLES

For each candle you will need:

- a pineapple slice
- a banana
- jam
- chopped nuts
- 1/4 red glace cherry
- a long very thin strip of licorice
- (Have an adult cut the licorice and cherry for you)



- 1) Drain the pineapple slice well on paper towelling. Place on a dish.
- 2) Peel the banana. Roll it in jam and then in chopped nuts. You may have to trim the curved end of the banana to make it stand straight.
- 3) Fit the banana into the hole of the pineapple slice. Stick the piece of glace cherry in the top to make the candle flame.
- 4) Bend the strip of licorice and push one end in at the pineapple base and the other end in the banana about half-way up.
- 5) Chill your banana candle in the refrigerator until you are ready to eat it.

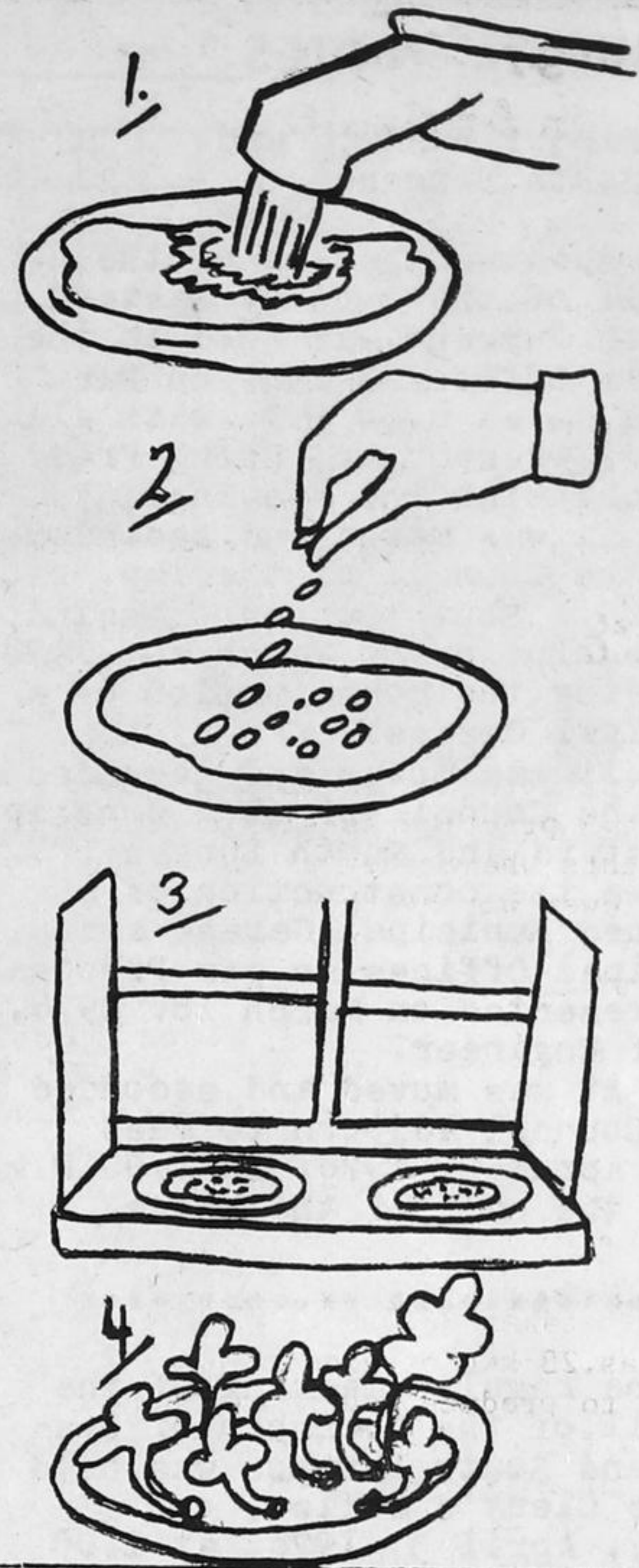

GROW YOUR OWN WINDOW SILL GARDEN

You will need:

- 2 flat dishes
- flannel or other soft material
- mustard seed
- cress seed

- 1) Cut out two pieces of cloth to fit inside the dishes. Place in dishes and dampen the cloth with water.
- 2) Sprinkle one dish with mustard seeds and the other with cress seeds.
- 3) Put both dishes in your window sill. Water the seeds when the cloth begins to get dry.
- 4) When the seedlings are 5-7.5 cm (2-3 inches) tall cut them and eat them in sandwiches or salad.
- 5) The mustard seed will be ready to cut in a week. The cress will be ready in about two weeks.
