The Council of the Corporation of the Township of South Crosby held 1978 Mill Rate at an increase of .3 Mill for Residential; and .5 Mill for Commercial and Business.

Where did the money come from:-

The Province of Ontario reduces the 1978 Levy against the ratepayers of the Township of South Crosby by contributing Grants in the amount of \$682,745.25 which equals \$2.06 per dollar of taxation. Due to the fact, there was an increase in Assessment in the amount of \$66,810.00 helped greatly to hold the low increase in the 1978 Mill Rate.
