**FERTILIZER:** Wood ashes are composed of 50 to 75 percent lime, so if you have a large stove and a small garden you may never need to buy lime again. In addition, ashes contain phosphorous, potash and other trace elements that are good for the garden. Best of all, ashes used for this purpose can be spread in the middle of winter. Just take them to the garden area and sprinkle them as evenly as possible on the snow. Come spring, they'll sink into the soil as the snow melts.

COMPLETION:

**INSECT REPELLENT:** During bug season, ashes can be used to repel insects in the garden. Encircle the tomato plants with wood ashes or spread them in long low mounds beside the row crops. Slugs and snails are especially reluctant to storm these barricades and other insects are discouraged by them.
