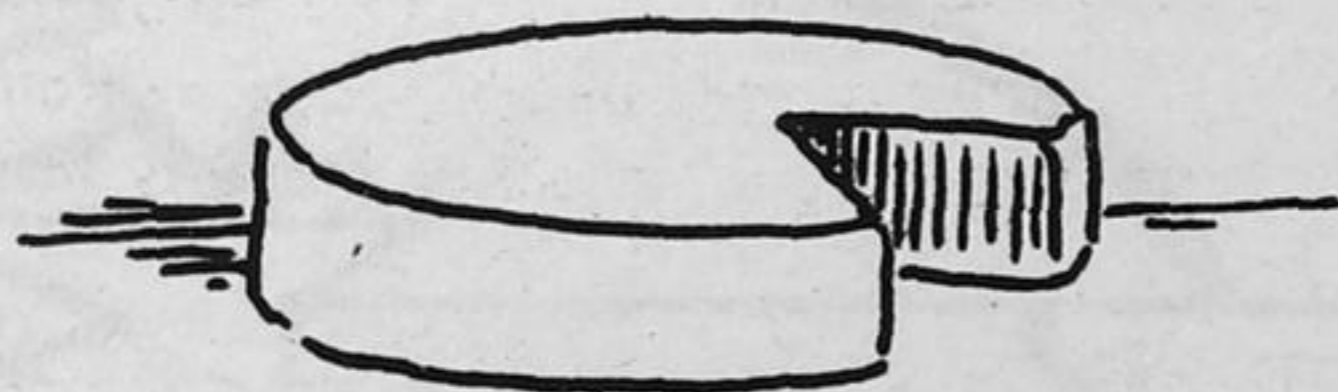
### Delta Library
