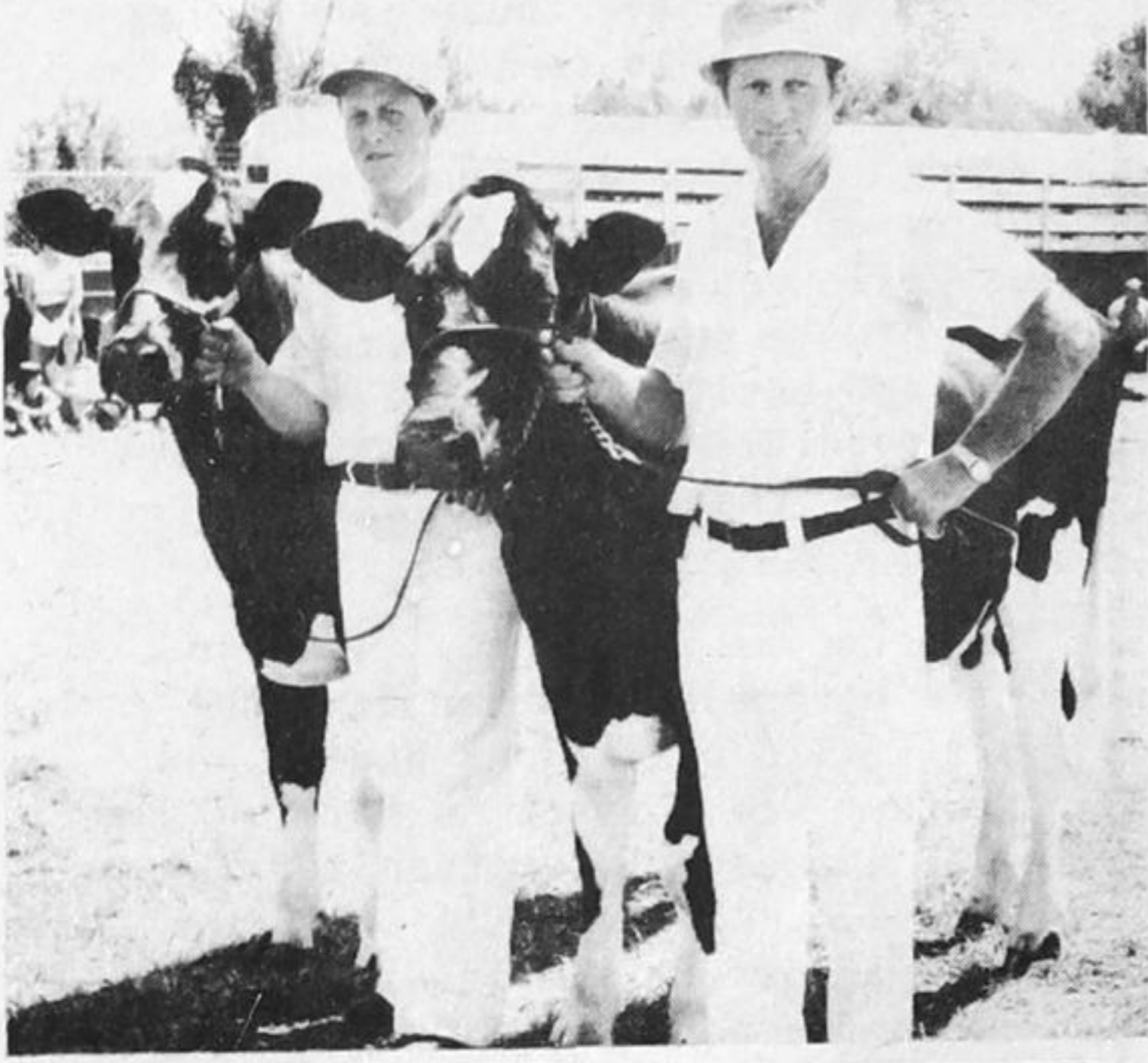
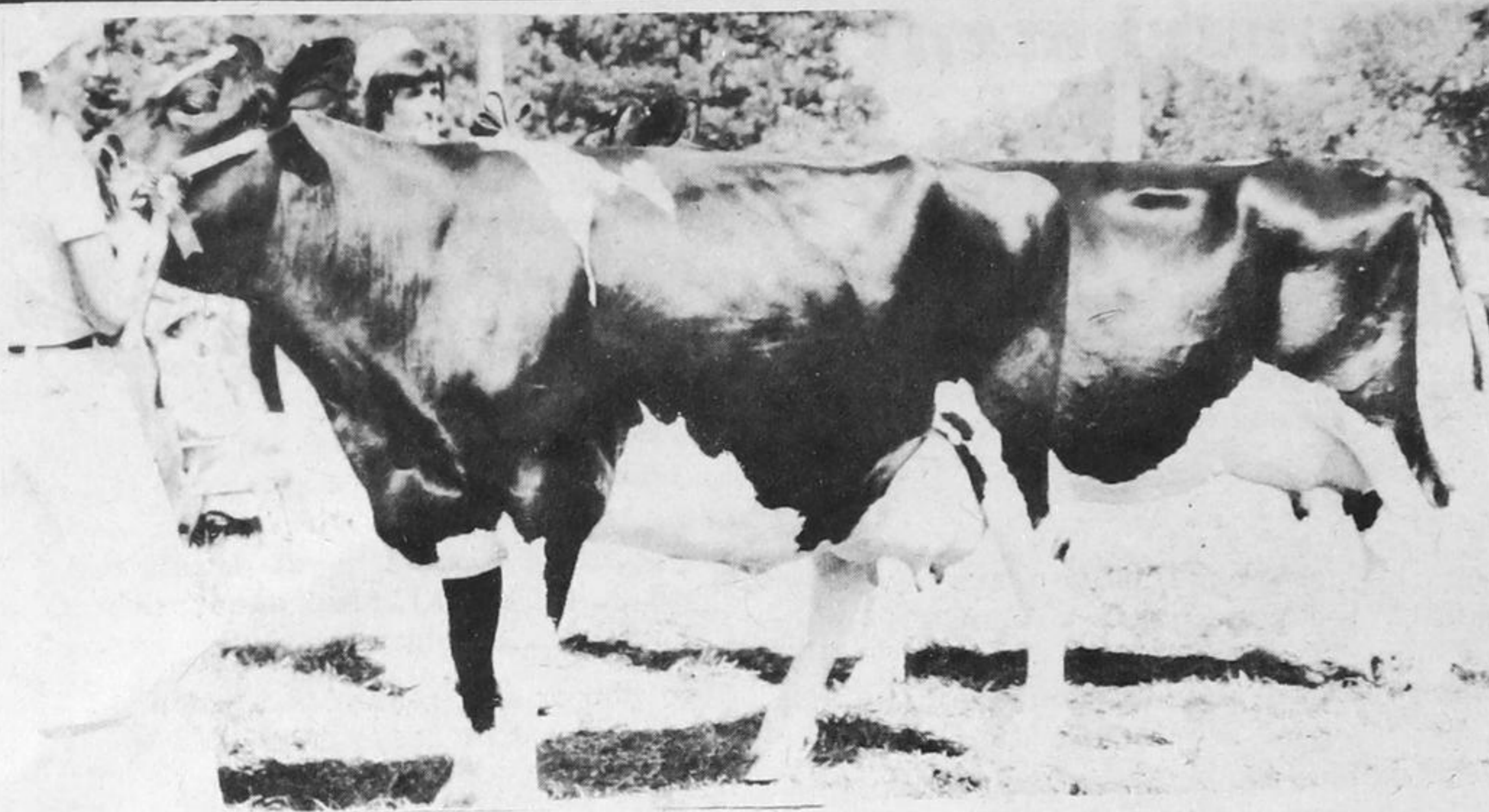


BLACK and WHITE

There was a top quality showing of Holstein cattle at Delta Fair this year. Judge Bob Flett, Oshawa placed 104 head shown by 20 exhibitors of the Leeds Holstein Club. The high quality of the cattle left Judge Flett with no easy task.

Top honours went to Goldendale Farm (Omer & Ralph Smith) of Lansdowne who captured the Premier Exhibitor, Premier Breeder, and Breeder's Herd awards. Other winners included: Jr. Champion Bull- North Star Holsteins (Stewarts, Lyn); Jr. Yearling heifer- North Star; Sr. Yearling- Arthur Modler & Sons (Lansdowne); 2-yr-old- John Asbreuk & Sons (Mallorytown); 3-yr-old- Goldendale; 4-yr-old- North Star; Best Udder- Goldendale.

First prize Aged Cow & Grand Champion of the show was Maple-dawn Citation Lady owned by Maple-Ain Holsteins (Gerald Hunter, Smiths Falls). A very large cow, Lady, is sired by Elmside View Supreme Dave. As a 3-yr-old in 305 days, she gave 7,661 kg. of milk, 296 kg. fat, testing 3.9%. Reserve champion was the 2nd prize Para Hill Fond Ivanhoe Aged Cow shown by Howard Chant, Portland.

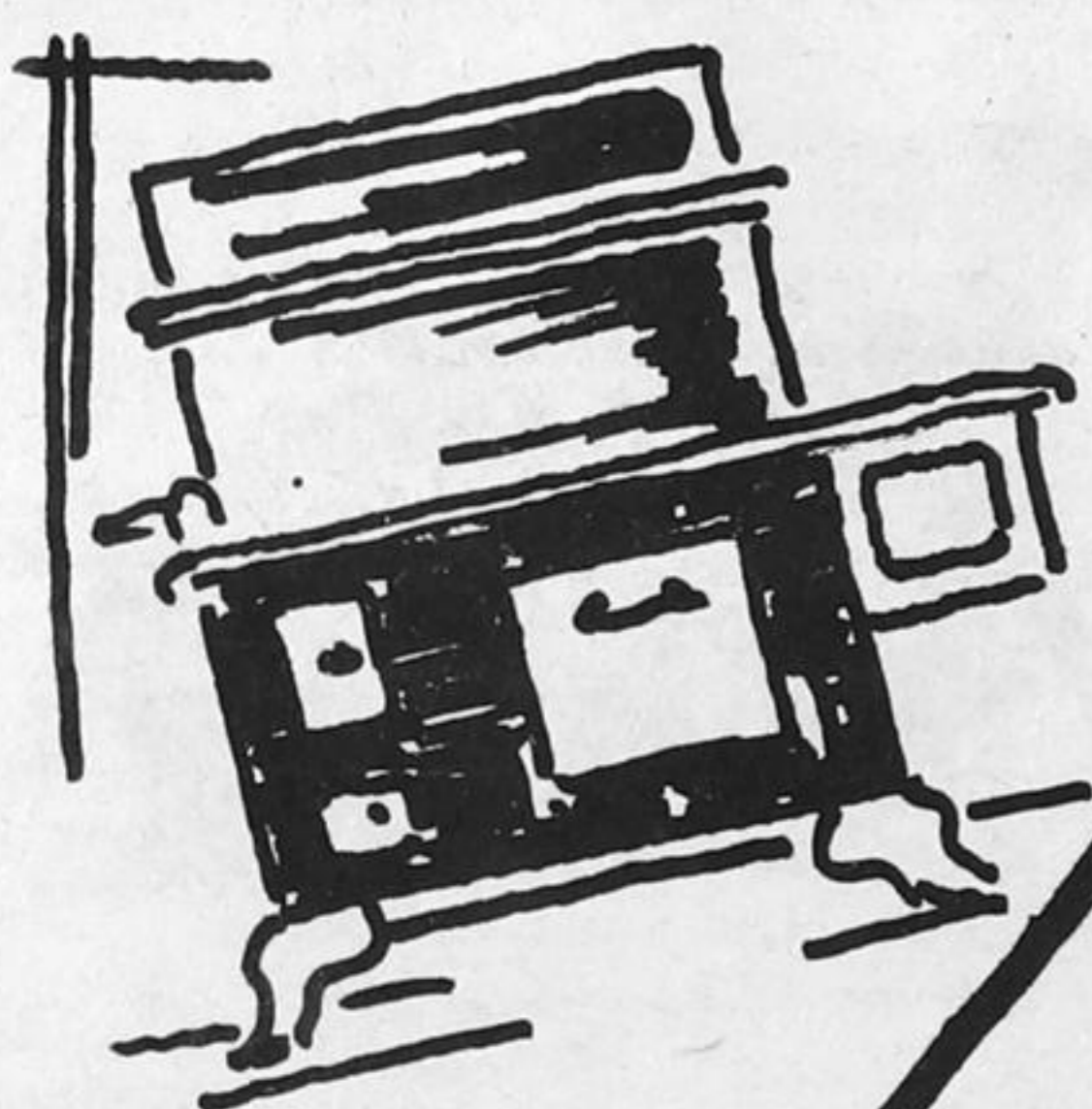
