Improvements Slated for Sweet's Corners School

The Leeds and Grenville Board of Education has allocated \$60,000 this year to upgrade facilities at Sweet's Corners Elementary School.

Work is to be carried out in the following areas:acquisition of learning materials, blackboards, bulletin boards; improved ventilation; a suspended ceiling and steel and glass enclosure for the resource and reading centre; relocation of lights and switching; and 100 steel student lockers.

According to Mr. Eyre principal at the school, priority will be given to improvements which most immediately affect learning. Thus, he hopes that work will be completed this summer on ventilation, lighting and installation of blackboards.

The Board of Education is presently getting prices from contractors on the work. Improvements will be carried out as funds permit.

Little Jack Horner Pie

2 14 oz. cans of Canada Choice Prune Plums

2 1/2 tablespoons cornstarch 1/4 teaspoon cinnamon

1/4 teaspoon cinnamon 1/4 teaspoon nutmeg

l tablespoon lemon juice Pastry for 9-inch two crust pie

Drain plums, pit and cut in quarters. Reserve syrup. Combine cornstarch, cinnamon and nutmeg with a little syrup. Add the remaining syrup.

Bring to a boil; cook stirring for 3-5 minutes. Remove from heat and add plums and lemon juice.

Allow to cool slightly and pour into unbaked pie shell. Top with lattice. Bake at 230°C(450°F) for 12 minutes. Reduce heat to 180°C(350°F) and bake for 20 minutes. Makes six servings.
