**Creation or Evolution (cont'd from p.13)**

The Genesis flood had a profound effect on the surface of the earth and is the key to understanding geology. Most of the characteristics of the crust of the earth—the thick beds of sediments, their fossil contents and strongmarks of erosion—came about through the action of flood waters.
