The Genesis flood had a profound effect on the surface of the earth and is the <u>key</u> to understanding geology. Most of the characteristics of the crust of the earth-the thick beds of sediments, their fossil contents and strong marks of erosion-came about through the action of flood waters.

I am thankful that there has been less rigid adherence to the evolutionary concept among geologists in the last few years. Even now scientists are looking for other answers. Why anyone wants to degrade themselves to the level of animals is beyond me.

God gave us the honour of having dominion over the fish of the sea, the fowl of the air and over cattle and every creeping thing. He gave us these animals to enjoy and study, but not to worship and idolize. Nature is God's 2nd book, the Bible being the 1st. We are to worship our Creator, not what he has created.
