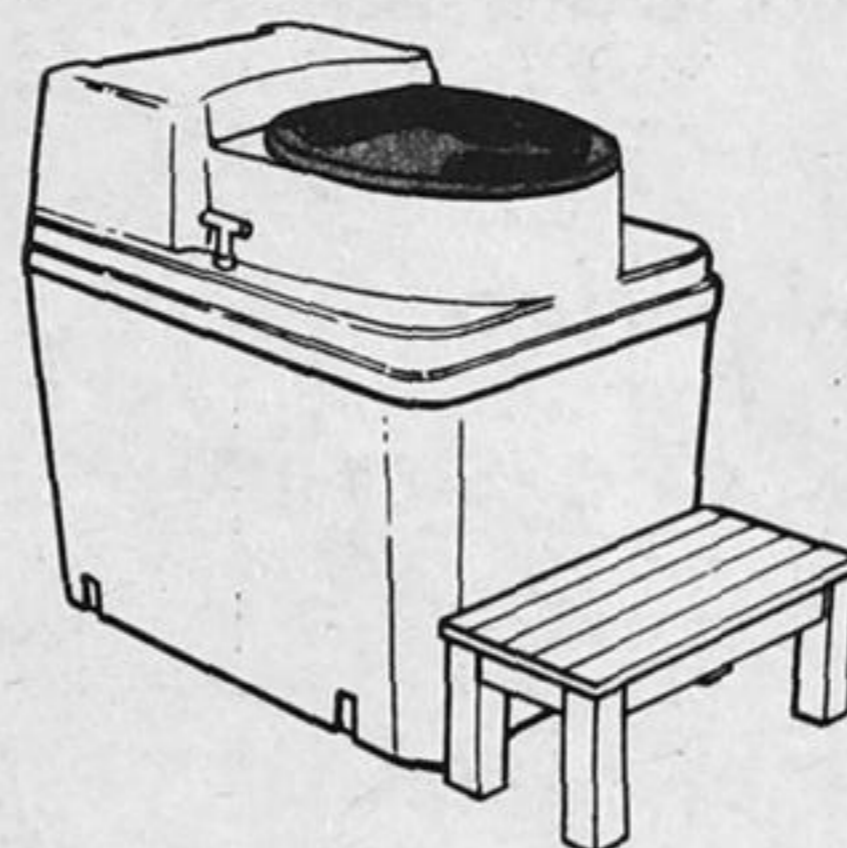

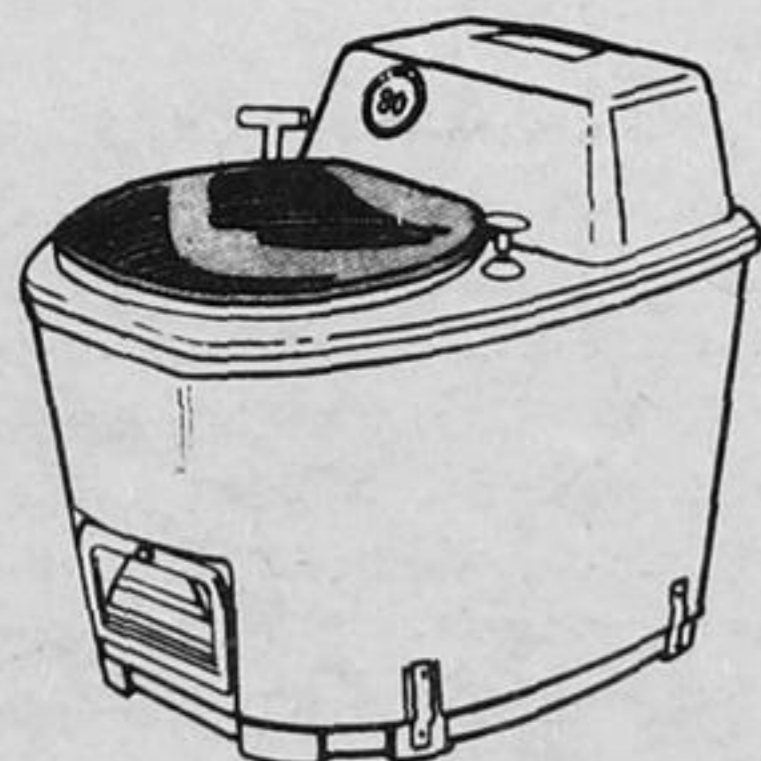

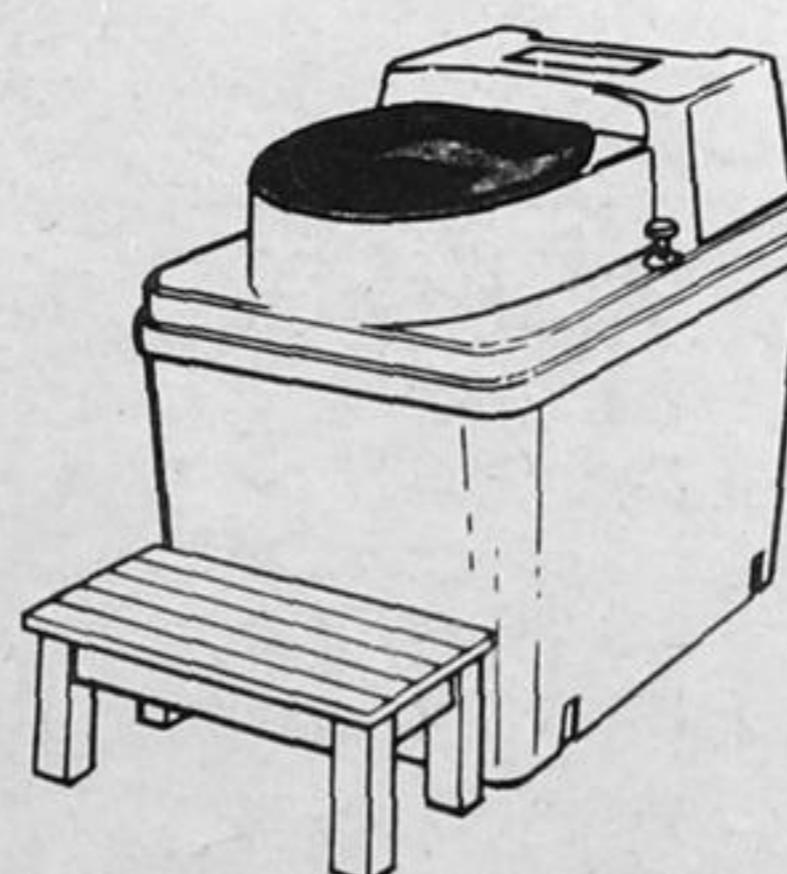
BOWLI-N.E.

57cm wide, 76cm high, 83cm long.



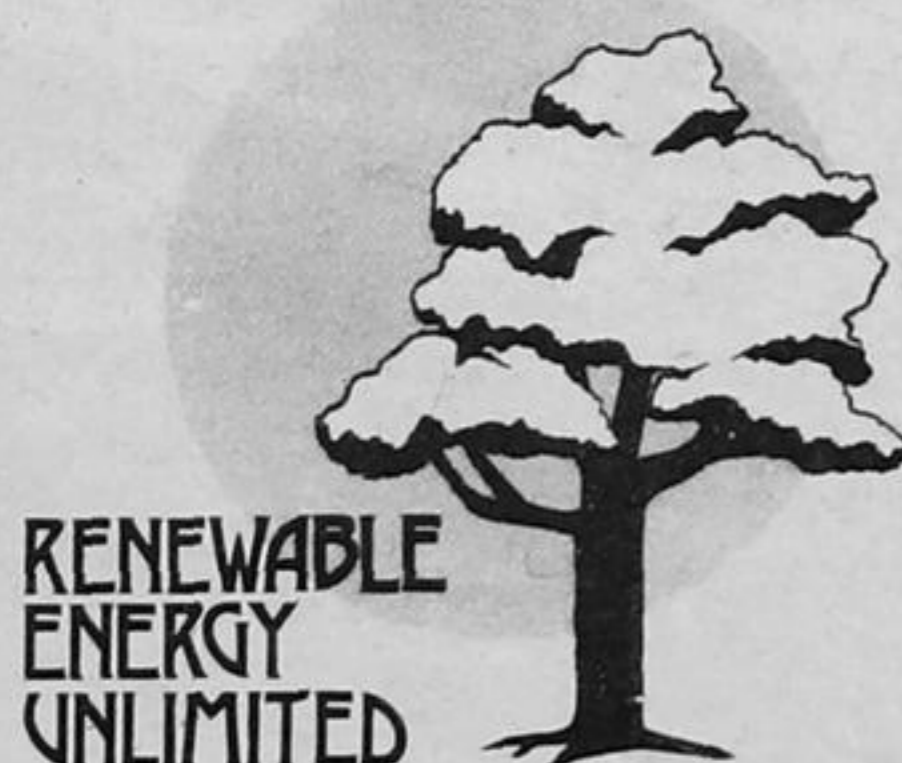
TROPIC-80
