RURAL ADULT READING PROGRAMME

The Rural Adult Reading Programme is for people who are not in school, but who would like to learn to read and write better.

About 1/3 of the people who are over 16 years of age have trouble reading well enough to get by. They may have trouble filling out bank deposit slips, or be unable to do their own old age security, OHIP or income tax forms. Other people have all the practical skills necessary to get their papers for their trade but can't write well enough to complete the exam. Still others would like to help their children who are in school, but can't. Most people don't realize how common problems in reading are.

The Reading Programme is free. Each 'student' is paired with a trained tutor who will work along with the person who wants to learn to read better. The tutor is helped by the library and the college to select materials to study that are best for each 'student'.

To start, the Reading Programme will be run from two library branches - Hartington and Mountain Grove. The librarians at these branches will have materials on hand for tutors to use and will also take the names of people who would like to be tutors or who would like to learn to read better.

The Reading Programme is being jointly sponsored by the Frontenac County Library and St. Lawrence College. If you would like more information either about being a tutor, or about learning to read, call or drop by at either of the places listed below:

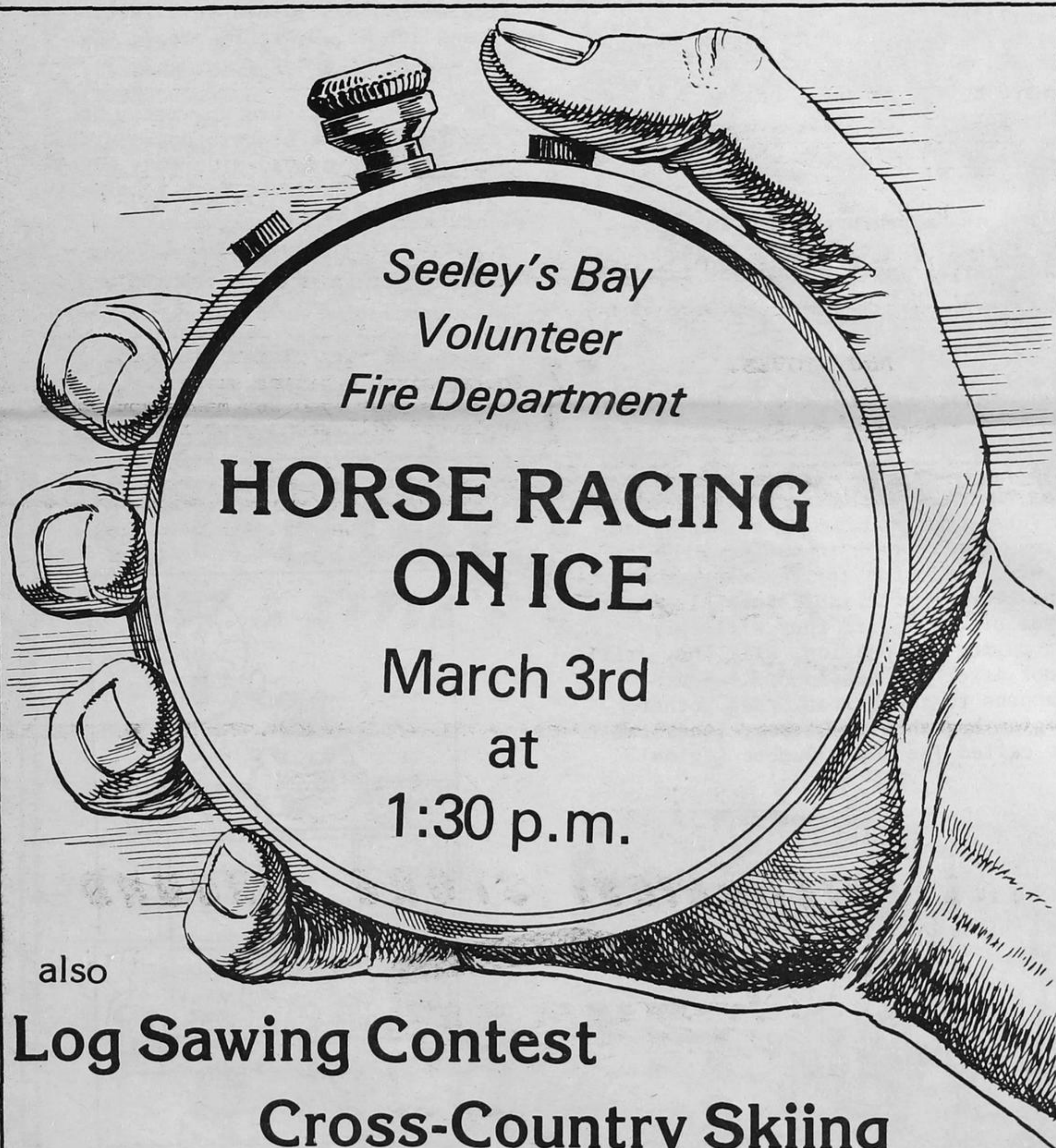
