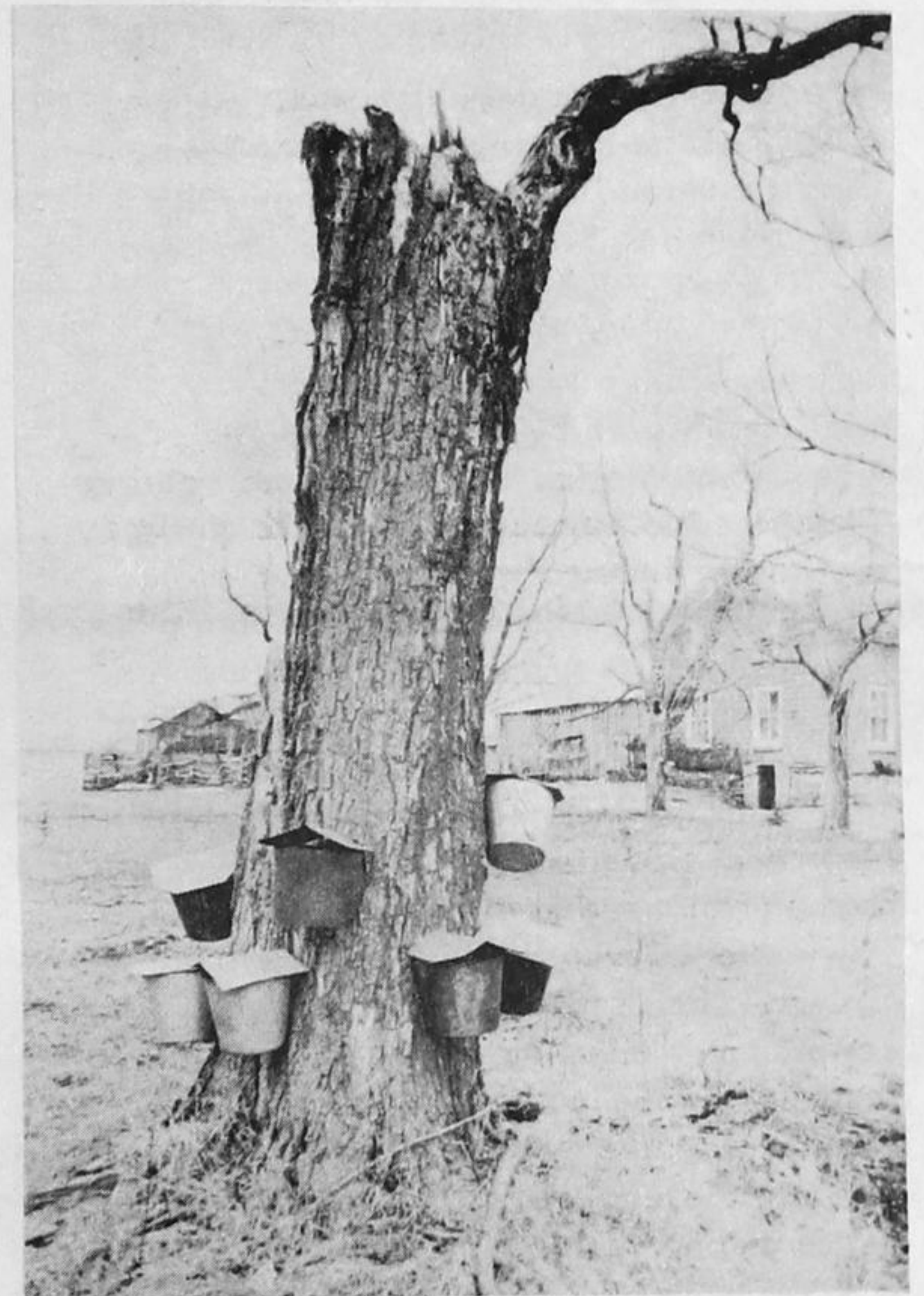
We wish to sincerely thank all those who participated and attended to make this event the success it was.

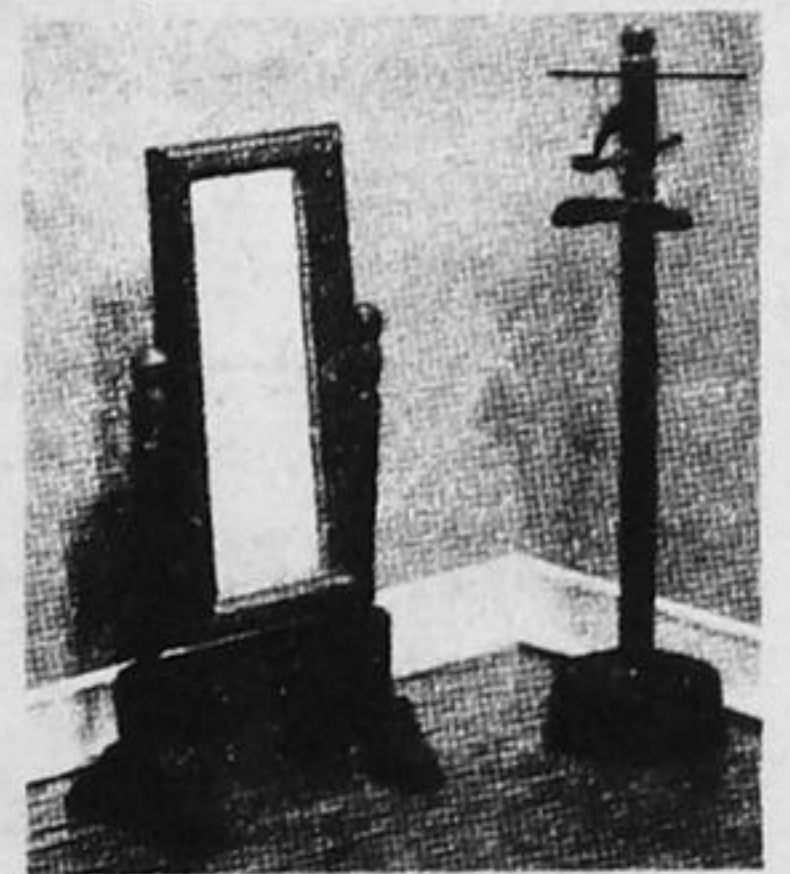
