General Voucher - \$17,006.79 Road Voucher - \$24,331.72 General Business followed:

- discussion on changes to be made in Municipal Building. - Wm. Elliott was appointed 1979 Warble Fly Inspector. - A Grant of \$200.00 for 1979 was made to Delta Fair Society. - Council support a resolution as presented by a delegation of concerned taxpayers as follows:

"That we support the Leeds and Grenville County Board of Education in their efforts of keeping settlements to a reasonable level in their present dispute with the Teacher's Federation, (across the board dollar settlement, rather than a percentage increase)."

- Council is to notify Fisheries and Environment that a decision for a Public Meeting will be decided after March 16. concerning the Public Wharf. - A Grant of \$400.00 for 1979 was made to North Leeds Lantern. - Council is requesting a Supplementary for Roads in the amount of \$46,975 for 1979.

- Council approved the Road Budget for 1979 in the amount of \$349,458.(normal \$199,166; supplementary \$78,292; DR-1296 \$72,000.)

- Council will take no action on the resolution of the Township of Front of Escott. - A grant for \$62,522.74 is requested under the Ontario Home Renewal Program for our Township.


- Council will advertise for a Dog Catcher for 1979. - Meeting adjourned to meet again April 2, 1979, at 1.00 P.M.
