In support of International Year of the Child, the Ontario Ministry of Health has established the "Food for Health" awards programme. The objectives of the programme are to develop nutrition awareness and learning, and to encourage the provision of more healthful foods at school.

Twenty awards of \$1,000 each are being made available to Ontario Secondary Schools to encourage the replacement of "junk foods" with more nutritious alternatives and the awards will be for use in future health-related activities for students. The student council will be the recipients of the award money.

Actual projects should offer a practical program on nutrition for students; involve the total school; be innovative and imaginative in approach; have the potential to become an ongoing program with ongoing impact; be developed and presented by the students, a school's administration or other groups representing the schools; and provide evidence that eating habits and/or nutrition knowledge have changed.

Why the awards? "The Ministry of Health has had a longstanding interest in the health of students and in the role the school environment can play in promoting good health habits. The health care system is focusing more and more on health promotion and the responsibility every citizen can assume in safeguarding his own health. The school has an important role to play in this endeavour by creating an

environment where learning and practice in good health habits can operate together. Through nutrition education, promotional activities and the goods made available at school, students can have the opportunity to both learn and practice sensible eating habits."

This program is very encouraging. Contrary to popular belief, many students are keen in improving their nutrition knowledge and habits.

In a survey of 142 high school students in Ottawa last February, the students eagerly offered suggestions on how teenagers could be encouraged to eat sensibly.


Nutrition Services at the Ontario Ministry of Health compiled a summary of school nutrition programmes and projects which have been carried out throuout the province. Three schools from Leeds, Grenville and Lanark counties submitted reports.

It is hoped that with the cash incentive all secondary schools in the 3 counties will wish to become involved in this important area of nutrition education.
