 and Westport stands Mr. N. S. Merriman's residence. The
 property was "pioneered" by the Singletons.

The property north west of Crosby owned at present
 by Mr. Adiel Baker was first owned by James Barker.
 Mr. Barker also owned the farm of Mr. G. G. Topping and
 later sold it to Mr. Michael Murphy, G. G. Topping's
 grandfather.

This short sketch of "Crosby History" includes all
 the facts at present available. There are no doubt
 several omissions--gaps which can be filled if those
 interested will forward reliable information concerning
 our village and its immediate vicinity.
