If a flock of geese see one of their number drink, they will drink too. Men often make geese of themselves.

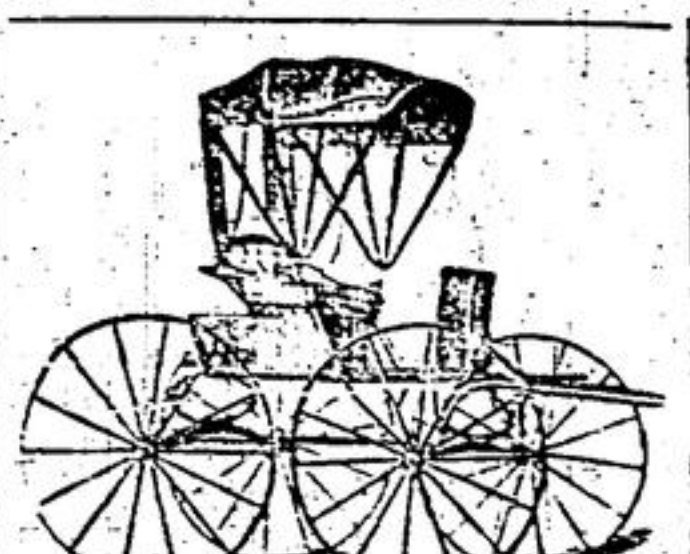
